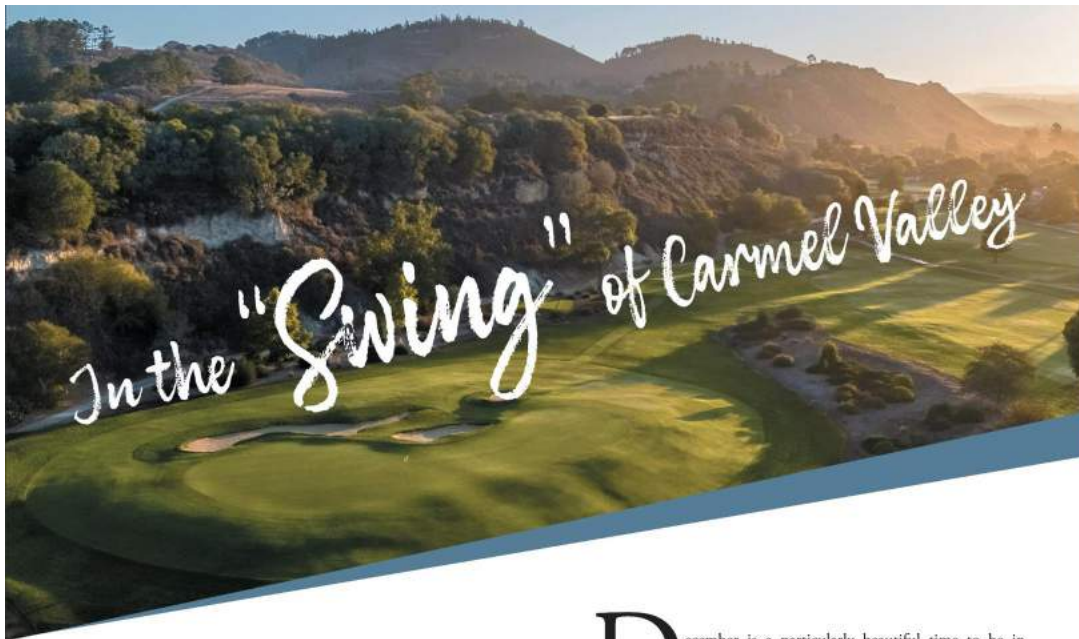

Quail Lodge, Carmel-by-the-Sea, California

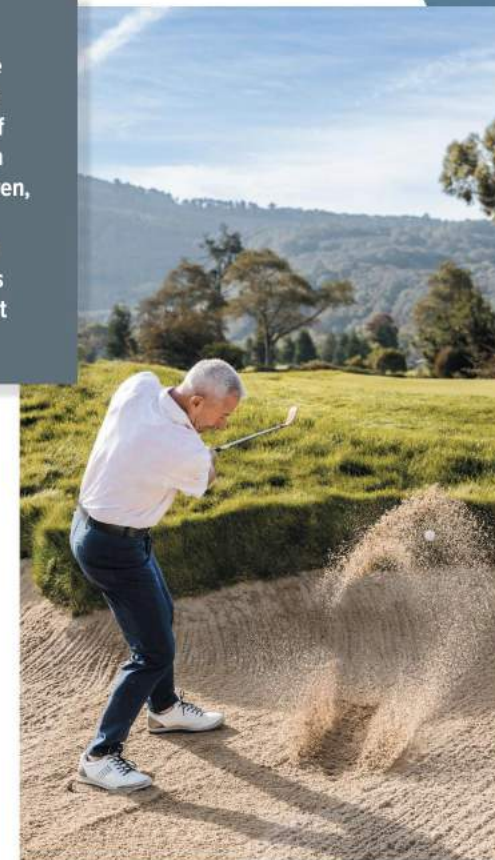
inform the welcoming look of the interiors.

Historic California Ranch and Spanish Colonial aesthetics are polished up with clean, updated furnishings and color palettes that underscore the modern Northern California lifestyle. Other interior features include private decks or patios overlooking the lakes, golf course, or lush gardens; fireplaces in suites, Fairway Villas, and some rooms; and spacious bathrooms with marble baths, deep soaking tubs, and separate shower stalls in most rooms.

The property's golf course is a destination in its own right, thanks in part to the Quail Lodge Golf Academy, offering customized lesson plans to help new and experienced players improve their game.
